There are inherent risks in using and working around workplace machines. Accidents could often be caused from the incorrect use of hand trucks, forklift trucks and conveyors. Warehouse tools, such as pallets, skids, cutting and strapping tools, have to be utilized carefully during unpacking, packing and loading.
