Forklift Training Tips

It is vital that all workplaces using forklifts have the following checklist or one equivalent on the premises. If all of the safety rules are being followed, each of these questions must be answered with a "yes". A "no" to whatever question indicates a procedural weakness that could lead to injury, damage to equipment or accident.

- 1) Is the pedestrian traffic separated from the forklift working area?
- 2) Is pedestrian access to forklift travel areas restricted by barriers?
- 3) The walkways for pedestrians are well-marked?
- 4) A sign is visibly clear stating a "lift truck in operation"?
- 5) There are mirrors provided at blind spots for operators and pedestrians?
- 6) Alterations or changes to the daily lift truck schedule has been communicated to employees?
- 7) The lift truck tires being utilized are suitable for all operating surfaces?
- 8) Lift truck seatbelt is being utilized?
- 9) Is the seat in good condition?
- 10) Is a regular forklift maintenance schedule followed?
- 11) Are yearly inspections of the forklift being carried out?
- 12) Is the kind of forklift appropriate for the job?
- 13) Does forklift has a readable load chart?
- 14) Could the operators read and understand the load chart?
- 15) The chart lists the safe lifting capacity for all attachments and their uses?
- 16) Do the forklift warning devices work correctly?
- 17) The speed operating control device is secured properly?
- 18) Is overhead cage fitted correctly on the lift truck?
- 19) Have all forklift operators obtained certification?
- 20) Warning signs and speed limits are being observed?
- 21) The operators have current training for the lift trucks being used?
- 22) Forklift operators understand their duties to report the damage to the machine and other lift truck incidences?
- 23) Is the pre-test checklist reviewed each and every day prior to the machinery being utilized?
